Luminosa Award for Unity 2014 awarded to Rev. John H. Armstrong

Conference on "Dialogue and Communion: How can we bear witness to the New Commandment?"

Panel discussion on **Saturday**, **June 21** afternoon Award celebration on **Sunday**, **June 22** morning at **Mariapolis Luminosa**, Hyde Park, NY

The Luminosa Award recognizes since 1988 persons or associations who have given a significant contribution to building bridges of mutual understanding and concern among the various Christian churches, major faith traditions and people of good will, in all aspects of social life.

This year's **Luminosa Award for Unity** will be awarded to Rev. John H. Armstrong, author and editor of several books, professor of evangelism at Wheaton College Graduate School, and founder and president of ACT3, a network of relational partnerships between churches, missions and leaders. In a letter notifying Rev. Armstrong of his nomination, the Luminosa Award committee expressed their desire to pay tribute to his "tireless work in Ecumenical dialogue", and, in a particular way, to his mission in helping Christians from different denominations work toward unity.
